Clarification of EPAC Referral Criteria

In a recent meeting with the staff from the EPAC clinic, we elected to clarify the referral criteria for EPAC clinic:

Included:

- Bleeding in pregnancy after 6 weeks as determined by LMP or ultrasound
- Non-viable pregnancies (missed or incomplete miscarriages) after 6 weeks
- Pregnancy of unknown location, with BHCG and ultrasound reports attached
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Excluded (should be managed by GP):

- Pregnancies under 6 weeks gestation
- Live intrauterine pregnancies, even if there is cramping
- Cramping in early pregnancy, without bleeding

Referral to Gyne on call:

- Active bleeding in early pregnancy
- Unstable patient
- Severe anemia with Hb <80
- Suspected or proven ectopic pregnancy
